**Holiday Shopping Safety Tips**

Personal safety is an issue that all needs to be concerned with while shopping during the holidays. As you shop, walk confidently and be alert at all times; Don't display large sums of money; Never leave your credit cards on the store counters at anytime; Carry your handbag or purse close to your body with the clasp or flap towards you; Shop with a family member or friend when possible; Report suspicious people or situations to security or police at once.

**Parking Lot Safety —Vehicle Theft Prevention**

Park and walk in well lit areas only; Never leave packages in open view of your windows; Avoid wearing expensive jewelry; After shopping when approaching your car look under, in the back seats and around before getting into car; Lock your vehicle when entering parking lot areas and as soon as your get into your car; Don't leave you children in the car even for a quick trip into the store; If you feel uncomfortable walking to your car ask store management, security, or police for an escort to your car.

**Travel Safety During the Holidays**

Before you leave make sure that your home looks "lived in"; Have your neighbors pick-up your papers and mail; Keep your trash cans off the street; Leave your blinds or shades in the normal positions; Put several lights and a TV on a timer; Supply your neighbor[s] with a contact number in case of an emergency.

While on your trip carry a minimum amount of cash, if carrying travelers checks keep the serial numbers in a separate place; Have your car serviced, check your tires for proper inflation and in good repair before your trip; Never pick-up hitchhikers; Carry a flashlight, flares, fire extinguisher, and a first-aid kit; When stopping for the night remove all valuables and bags; Leave your travel itinerary with a family member or friend before leaving on your trip.
